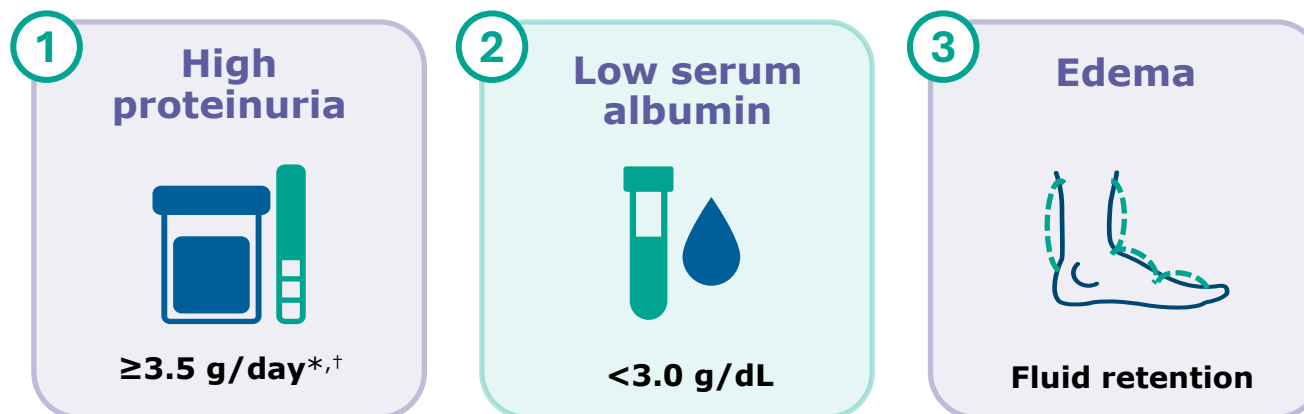


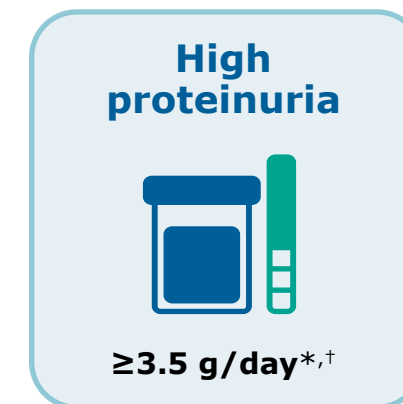
How Does Nephrotic-Range Proteinuria Differ From Nephrotic Syndrome in Focal Segmental Glomerulosclerosis (FSGS)?

► Nephrotic Syndrome



All 3 diagnostic criteria must be met concurrently

► Nephrotic-Range Proteinuria



Single criterion

Not all patients with nephrotic-range proteinuria have nephrotic syndrome

*Or equivalent in adults. †Proteinuria $\geq 2.0 \text{ g/g}$ in pediatric patients < 18 years old.

Nephrotic syndrome is defined by the concurrent presence of 3 diagnostic criteria and is distinct from both nephrotic-range proteinuria and primary FSGS
